ACHIEVEMENT

Electrification Project

The first concern of the Managing Trustees was to provide electricity to the 52 Resettlement Townships. The Board considered it unacceptable that the people who sacrificed so much to make the Akosombo Dam possible should be without electricity over forty (40) years after the construction of the Dam. The first major step taken by the Trust Fund therefore was to commission a study leading to the supply of electricity to all the 52 resettlement townships. The study was accepted by Government and funding was secured from the Chinese Government. The project commenced in October 2000 and completed in 2003.

A number of projects in the areas of health, education, social welfare and water and sanitation have been undertaken to bring relief to the resettled communities since the establishment of the Trust Fund.
