

# GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THE VENDOR'S INFORMATION SHEET

## 1. Code Of Ethics for VRA Vendors

Vendors of the Volta River Authority (VRA) are required to demonstrate values, standards and moral behaviour that support the mission and values of the Authority and are expected to behave themselves in a manner worthy of public trust.

The following are some relevant codes of conduct to guide vendors in the course of conducting business with the Authority.

1.1 **Fairness and Transparency** - VRA has a track record of meticulous and fair assessment of offers. All processes will be transparent, fair and confidential. No Vendor shall be subjected to any form of discrimination in the procurement process.

1.2 **Offering Business Courtesies** - Vendors are not required to offer business courtesies under any circumstance to any staff of VRA.

1.2.1 A Tenderer or its agent who attempt to influence an evaluation process or award decisions, including the offering or giving of bribes, gifts or inducements could result in the annulment of their tender and the forfeiture of their tender security (where applicable).

1.2.2 All contacts with Vendors or Tenderers will be for the purpose of clarification only and will be initiated by VRA in writing.

## 2. Completion of Vendor Forms (New Registration)

- Vendors must be registered with the Public Procurement Authority (PPA)
- Vendors must have a Tax Identification Number (TIN)
- Vendors must download and print the Form
- Vendors must complete the printed Forms appropriately
- All mandatory fields on the Form must be populated
- Vendors must review the information entered for accuracy
- Vendors must sign and stamp the printed Form
- Signed completed Forms and the accompanying documents should be scan as one PDF and emailed to [vendor.registration@vra.com](mailto:vendor.registration@vra.com)

### **3. Renewals**

- Vendors who seek to renew their registration should scan their valid PPA certificate or receipt of payment to PPA and their previous VRA vendor registration letter to the email address provided above in point 2

### **4. Feedback After Registration**

Note that upon completing and emailing the Forms, you will receive a confirmation of registration via the email provided within three (3) working days

### **5. Participation in Tenders**

Once registered you may duly participate in Tenders advertised

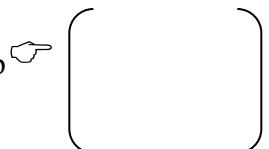
